BAPTISMS

Baptisms are held at 12 noon on the 2nd and 4th Sundays of the month. Parents must attend a Pre-Jordan class held in the Wright Center at 12 noon on the first Sunday of every other month. Registration for the class is required. In order to arrange for a baptism, the parents must be active members of the parish. To register, please call the rectory office at 610/789-7676 ext. 101. Godparents should be practicing Catholics, confirmed and at least 16 years of age. If not from this parish, sponsors must have a letter of eligibility from their parish stating that they have been actively participating . St. Bernadette Parishioners must be registered and actively participating.

MARRIAGES

We request that couples contemplating marriage call the rectory to make an appointment with the priest. At this initial interview, the date and time of your request will be recorded and you will receive a copy of the Parish Wedding Guidelines.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK/COMMUNION CALLS

THE PASTOR'S COLUMN

"Ephphatha!" that is, "Be opened!"

In today's Gospel we hear about Jesus performing another miracle, healing a man who is deaf and mute. We have to remember that although these stories were written long ago they are for us now as well. We can think of it this way...

We are all blind. We are all deaf. We are all in need of God's healing. But the healing that God wants for us is not to solve our eye problems or our ear problems. He wants us to solve the problems of the heart. So what we see, we see the glory that God has given us to see the world as He sees it. And when we hear, He gives us the glory of His name that we might hear all the wonders of the Word of God as it comes to us and He gives us a mouth to sing His praise.

This is what Mark is saying. He's saying we are a community of people and we should be listening to each other, not with our ears, but with our hearts. And we should be praising God and each other, not with our mouth, but with our heart as well. You must speak with your heart, hear with your heart, love with your heart, and then you will understand that God is with us.
